Greetings and Merry Christmas from Rancho el Refugio. We want to thank all of our current partners who have given of their finances, time and talents. Your generosity has helped sustain and advance ministry in the Ensenada and Ojos Negro communities.

We are so grateful for your continued prayer and partnership!

Good News! We would like to provide details of some very good news that was mentioned in our previous newsletter. Government grants were made available for Puente de Vida school for grounds improvement. After discussing several potential projects with families of students who attend the school, we have agreed upon two projects that will get started after the grant and plans have been approved by the local government officials.



Project 1: Exterior Courtyard: Currently the courtyard outside of the school is dirt and very rough. There will be three phases to this project. First, a wall will be built along the road in front of the school to enlarge the area of the courtyard. Next, the ground will be leveled, drains will be put in and then concrete will be poured. Finally, a covered area will be built in the courtyard so that a shaded area will be available for parents to enjoy watching their children and for when teachers want to bring a class outside and not be in the sun.



Project 2: Soccer Field/Basketball Court: The second project will be a combination soccer field/basketball court. Walls will be built around the soccer field and nets along the south side to keep the balls in play and to prevent them from going out in the road. The soccer goals will have a backboard and hoop attached to them so they can also be used for basketball. All this will be set in concrete so that this area can be used year-round. Indeed a very welcome change from playing in dirt and also not being able to play at all during the rainy season.

All this has been made possible because of the great parent involvement in our school and their willingness to make Puente de Vida a better place for their children to learn.

School Christmas Program

The students are preparing for the end of the first semester and getting ready for Christmas. This year there will be a Christmas Program on December 20. Normally this is done inside the “Barn”, but due to COVID-19 restrictions, the program will be in the courtyard outside of the school. You are welcome to attend! This is a highlight for our students and staff as they celebrate the Christmas season.
